

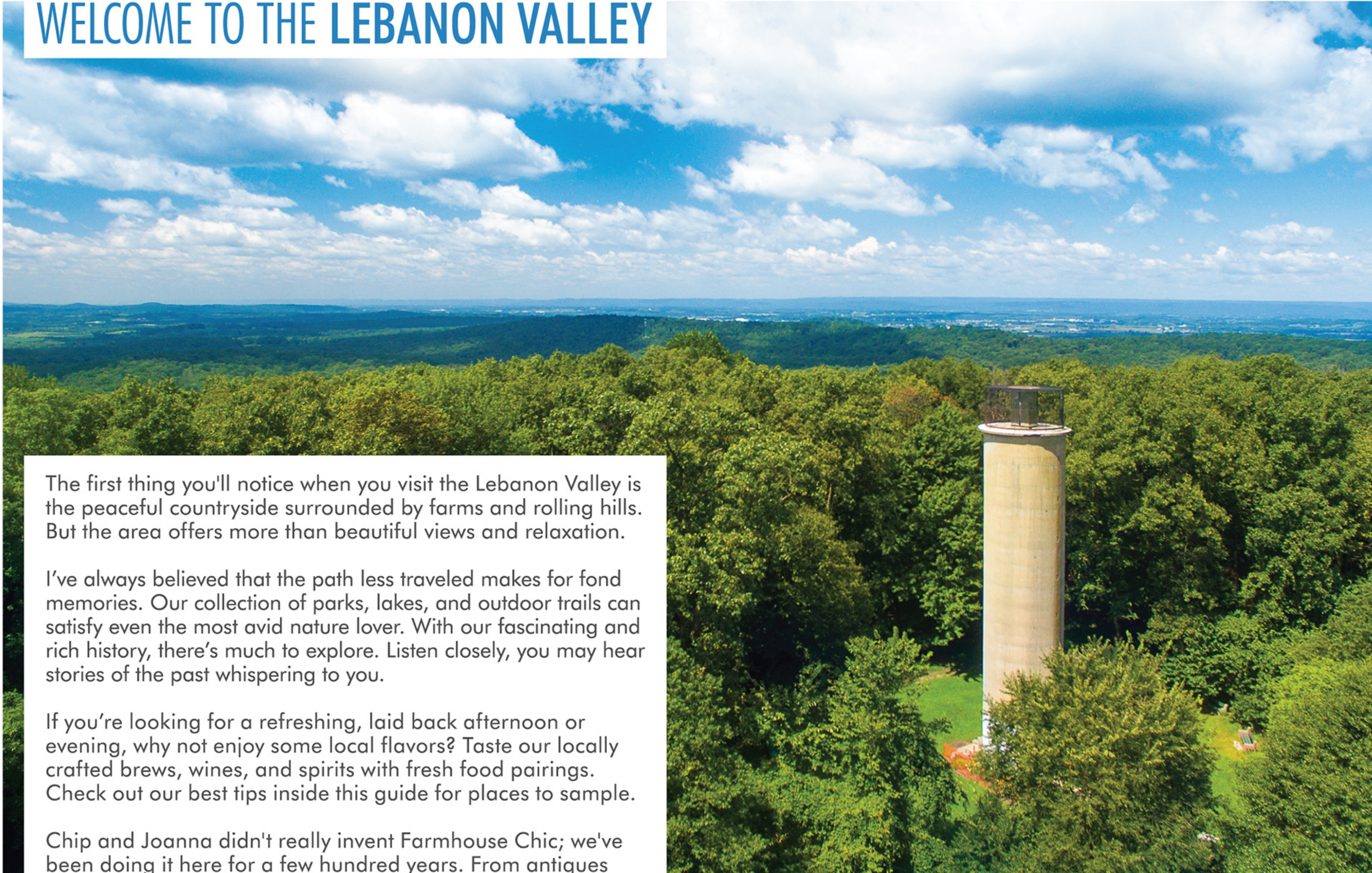

IT'S TIME TO EXPLORE

The Lebanon Valley has a long tradition of distilling and brewing. Along the Libations Trail you have the chance to savor the area's spirits, craft beers, wines, ciders, and slushies. With names like Annville IPA, Opera Fudge Stout, and Governor Dick Pale Ale, you'll learn some of the Valley's history and legend. You may even find a new favorite drink.

Experience breathtaking scenery and a bird's eye view of the Lebanon Valley. Speaking of birds, did you know that 100,000 snow geese stop here on their way to their Arctic nesting grounds? The Lebanon Valley is also home to a threatened butterfly species. If you're seeking an adventure, the area offers many outdoors options including fifteen miles of tree lined railroad track beds to hike or bike. Or, kayak the waterways to view up close a historically registered lenticular truss bridge.

In the Lebanon Valley you'll find history with every step you take. Did you know that the Lebanon Valley is home to the only existing cold-blast iron furnace in the United States? The area also has the oldest existing transportation tunnel, and offers canal boat rides for an immersive experience into history. Speaking of immersive, take the opportunity to journey back in time by spending a day on an 18th century farm. Or, why not enjoy a play at one of the oldest open-air theatres, the Mt. Gretna Playhouse? Before you say goodbye to the Lebanon Valley, visit the Pennsylvania Veterans Memorial and pay your respects to generations of military heroes.

From Opera Fudge to caramel corn, whimsical gifts to furniture, antiques and even homemade Baklava, the Lebanon Valley has many antique and local artisan shops for you to peruse. Who knows, you might even find that elusive item needed to complete your collection, or stumble upon a must-have handmade item by a nationally known artisan.

Appalachian Trail • The Appalachian Trail is the longest hiking-only footpath in the world and includes a moderate 9.5-mile hike through the Lebanon Valley. • nps.gov/appa

Camp Mack • This 1,000+ acre property is open to the public for mountain biking, hiking, and trail running with 15 miles of trail maintained by SAMBA, ranging from easy to difficult. • sambabiker.com

Clarence Schock Memorial Park at Governor Dick • Hike to the summit of the Clarence Schock Memorial Park at Governor Dick to catch a 360-degree view of Lebanon County and the surrounding four counties. • parkatgovernordick.org

Coleman Memorial Park • Once a grand estate of the Coleman Family with mansions, stables, an ice-house, and gate house, it lives on today as a community-focused park with an amphitheatre, ball fields, and playgrounds. • colemanmemorialpark.com

Lebanon Valley Bicycle Coalition • Cycle your way through Lebanon Valley's farmland, historic gems, gaps, and vistas with the help of the Lebanon Valley Bicycle Coalition and their 10 themed rides and accompanying maps. • bikelebanon.org

Lebanon Valley Rail Trail • This mixed-use greenway offers users of all ages and abilities the opportunity to explore the social and industrial history of our area. • lvrailtrail.com

Memorial Lake State Park • Memorial Lake offers outdoor recreation year-round, including a chance to observe more than 100 different land and water species during the migratory season. • dcnr.pa.gov

Middle Creek Wildlife Management Area • This 6,000-acre tract is set aside for the protection and management of wildlife and is a Globally Significant Important Bird Area. • pgc.pa.gov

Quittapahilla Creek • Along with being stocked seasonally, this stream features several characteristics ranging from a typical limestone spring creek to a more freestone character, making it a popular fly fishing destination. • fooa.org

Regal Fritillary • Fort Indiantown Gap has restored an Eastern Native Grasslands for the repatriation of the threatened Regal Fritillary Butterfly. • ftig.png.pa.gov

SAMBA • The Susquehanna Area Mountain Bike Association is a member-supported organization that maintains over 65 miles of trail surrounding Harrisburg, PA including over 25 miles here in the Lebanon Valley. • sambabiker.com

Sand Siding Trail • Just a 5-minute walk from the Sand Siding Trailhead and Parking area, the Sand Siding Trail crosses the Swatara Creek with 4 connected bridges giving you a near tree-top view of the resident birds and vernal ponds. • dcnr.pa.gov

Second Mountain Hawk Watch • Perched atop the ridge, Second Mountain Hawk Watch overlooks Fort Indiantown Gap and Stony Valley. Its location lies in the path of hawks migrating from August through December. • stonyvalley.com

State Game Lands 211 • At 44,343 acres, State Game Lands 211 has so much to explore and experience. With so much wilderness, keep an eye out for Red-Spotted Newts, Barred Owls, Deer, Porcupine, and a wide array of birds. • pgc.pa.gov

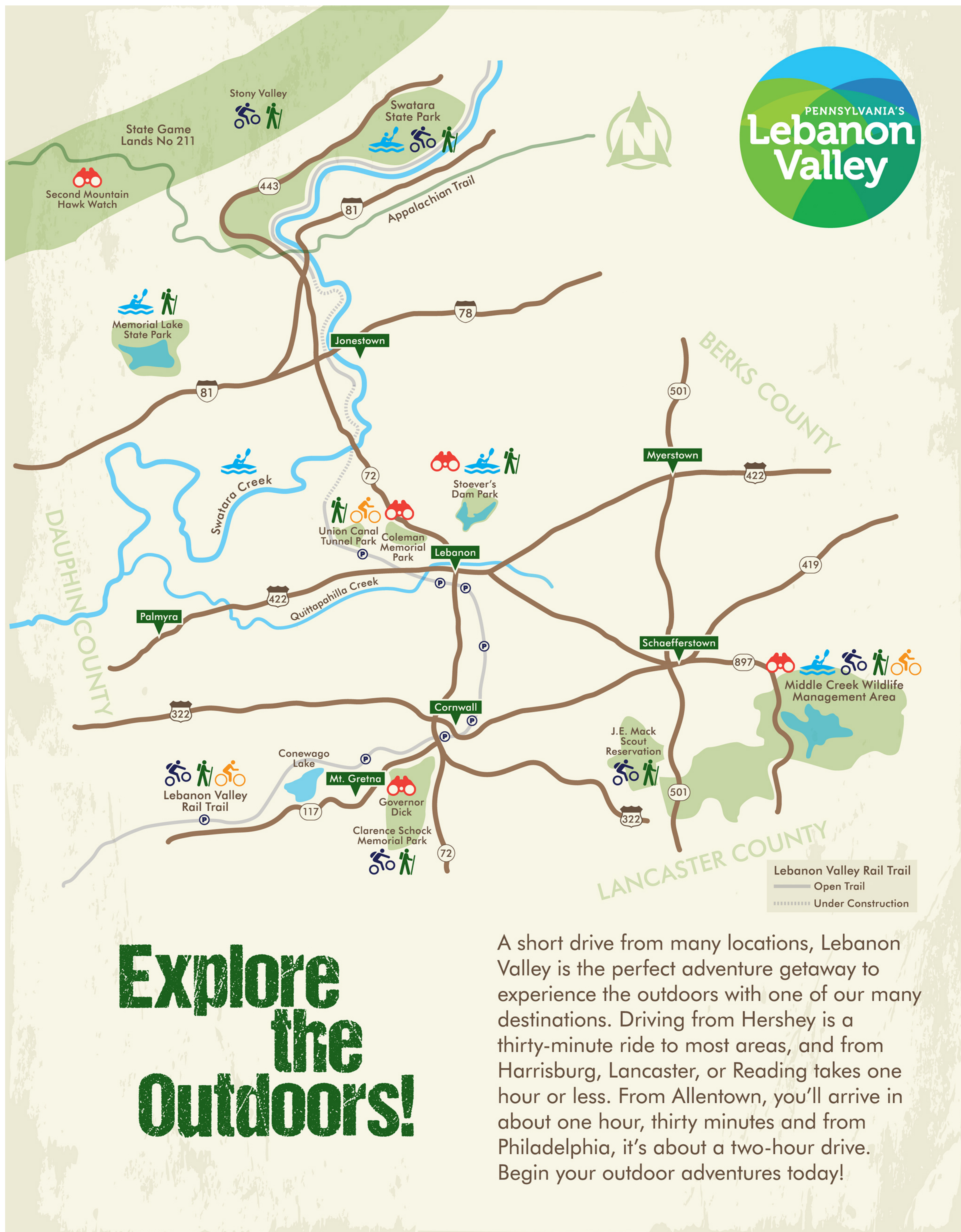
Stoever's Dam Park • Located just outside of Lebanon City, this 153-acre park offers camping, picnicking, hiking, and a 23.5-acre lake for canoeing and fishing. • visitlebanonvalley.com

Stony Valley Trail • Stony Valley is part of the second largest roadless wilderness tract of land in Pennsylvania and boasts a 19-mile trail system with many shorter hikes available. • stonyvalley.com

Swatara Creek • The Swatara Water Trail offers 60-miles of outdoor recreation including canoeing, kayaking, and tubing. Experience the Swatara Creek first hand from one of numerous designated launches. • swatarawatershed.com

Swatara State Park • The 3,520-acre Swatara State Park provides 18.2 miles of hiking trails for all skill levels including the Swatara Rail Trail, the Appalachian Trail, and local favorite Bear Hole Trail. • dcnr.pa.gov

Union Canal Tunnel Park • The 110 acres of recreational open space features three historical locks that were part of the Union Canal, and includes a number of trails running along pasture, wooded areas, the canal, and farmlands. • lebanoncountyhistoricalsociety.org

DIGGING UP THE PAST

by Mary L. Weigley

Step inside the two-story, limestone building built in the 1780s that houses the Lebanon County Historical Society and imagine yourself in a different time. Dig up a Lebanon County branch of your family tree in the excellent Hauck Memorial Library and Archives.

Walk the trail at Union Canal Tunnel Park and imagine yourself leading a canal boat along the towpath. Take a narrated canal boat tour through the oldest existing transportation tunnel in the United States. Enjoy a picnic lunch and take a look at the reconstructed Krall Barn, a Pennsylvania German log barn built in the late 1700s.

Lebanon Farmers Market/Visit Lebanon Valley office is worth a visit. This building houses the original jail. The infamous Blue-eyed Six, inspiration to Sir Arthur Conan Doyle for the Sherlock Holmes story, "The Red-Headed League", were kept in the basement cells awaiting trial.

Cornwall Iron Furnace was a major iron producer from 1742 to 1883. Founded by Peter Grubb, the furnace was later purchased by the Coleman family, who established an iron dynasty in Lebanon County. The furnace supplied everything from stoves and cookware to cannons and munitions.

Historic Schaefferstown offers three historic areas to explore. The Brendle Museum houses treasures from Schaefferstown's past. Explore the Alexander Schaeffer Farm during one of the annual festivals. Walk the stone road, as heritage cattle grazing in the adjoining fields, and enter another time. Sheep graze in the orchard and guinea hens call to

one another. Local artisans craft the everyday items our ancestors used to make their lives easier.

Travel to Mt. Gretna, stand next to a wooded area, and enjoy a quiet moment. Walk by the charming cottages, many dating to the beginning of the Pennsylvania Chautauqua movement. Enjoy a class at the Hall of Philosophy or a service at the Tabernacle.

Fort Indiantown Gap was built on the location of a fortification from the French and Indian War when settlers were attacked by local Indians. One of the infamous Blue-eyed Six is buried in the Moonshine Church Cemetery. Visit the Pennsylvania National Guard Military Museum and the National Cemetery. Gaze at the Pennsylvania Veterans Memorial.

History is more than names and dates. Visit the Lebanon Valley, stay in an historic bed-and-breakfast, and dig up the past.

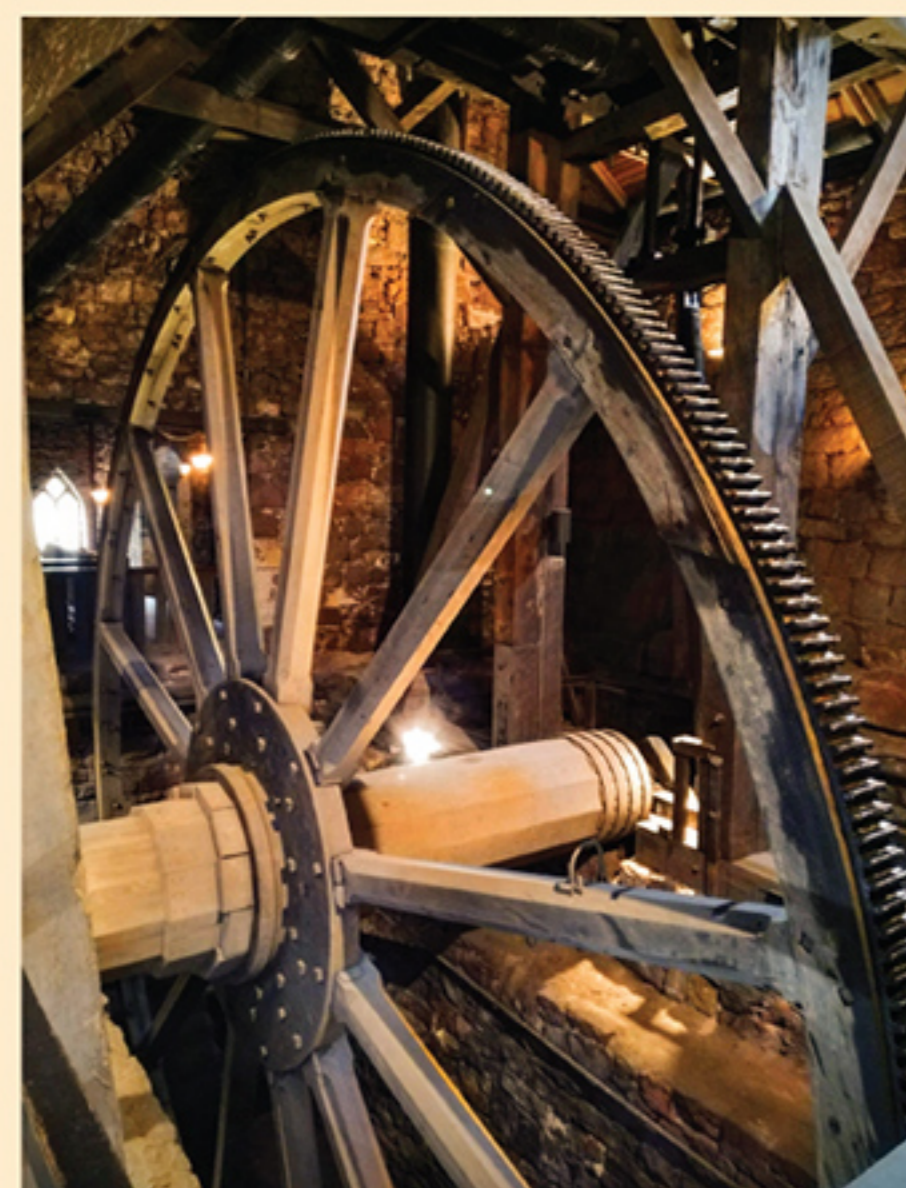

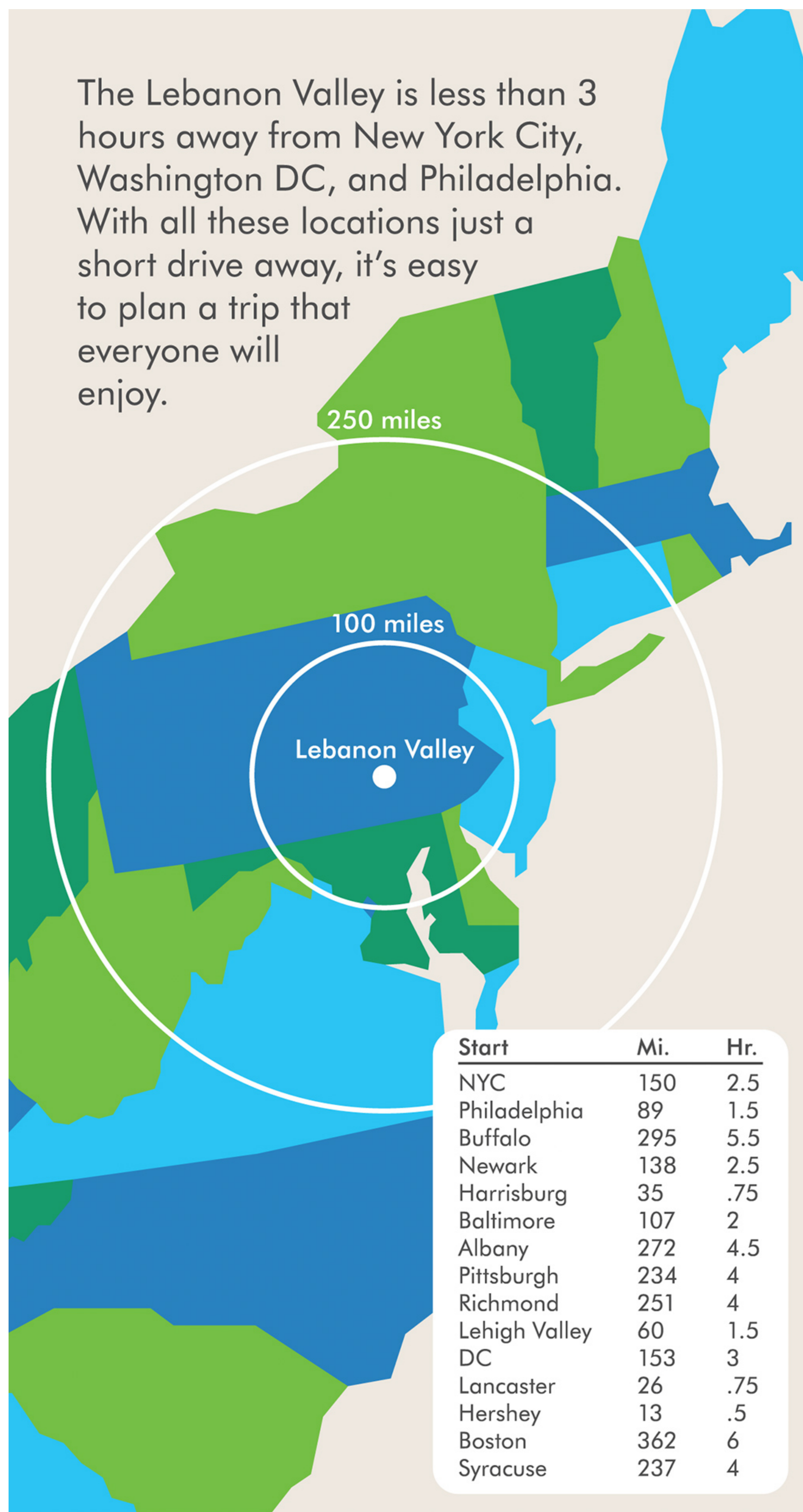

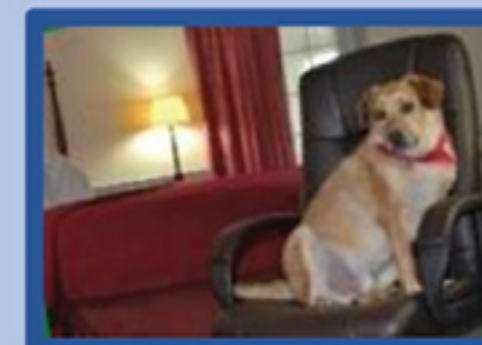
